What is a Named Social Worker?

Different models are developing, but they include things like:

- ◆ Being a primary point of contact for someone with a learning disability
- ◆ Acting as an advocate for that person
- ◆ Ensuring support for that person's needs from a medical perspective are balanced with their needs from a social perspective

What does it mean to take part in the pilot?

The Department is looking for two further sites with serious ambition to use a Named Social Worker model to change the lives of people with learning disabilities.

You will receive some financial support as well as support to design, implement and evaluate your approach.
